The students in grades 3, 4, 5 and 6 at Tri-County Elementary laughed and learned with Circus Arts artist, Benjamin Domask-Ruh the week of February 10th – 14th. Benjamin Domask-Ruh is a performing artist who combines the skills of circus and theatre to create a positive arts learning experience for students. He teaches them circus arts, gives them confidence to perform and reaches each students' abilities.
