As a reminder, starting tomorrow, Tri-County School will be in hybrid learning. This will continue through Friday, November 6th. Students in grades PreK-3 will be attending school M-Th. Meal delivery will be available to families outside the city limits of Karlstad. Those families in the city limits of Karlstad are asked to pick up their meals at South Entrance #14 from 11-Noon.

In regards to packet delivery, we ask that all families that are receiving meals, that are not in school on Monday and Tuesday (Group B students) or who are at-home learning to please have a covered tote or cooler left outside Monday morning. Technology and packets will be delivered. Also, those students in Group B should check Google Classroom and their school email regularly.

Coronation has been rescheduled to Wednesday, October 28th. The same times and procedures that were in place for tomorrow will be in place Wednesday. Please contact Student Council Advisory Mallory Schaumburg and visit our webpage or our Facebook as we update that information.

Lastly, we were notified yesterday afternoon of another lab-confirmed case of COVID-19 in a member of the Tri-County School community with an exposure date of October 20. Working with MDH and public health, contact tracing has been done and families of students considered to be a close contact have been contacted and advised to stay home and away from other people. If you have not been contacted, your child(ren) are not considered a close contact. Due to the uptick in numbers in Kittson and Marshall Counties, there will be no sports or activities after school this week. All games and practices are cancelled for the week.
