

Tri-County School District E-Learning Plan

On days when school is canceled due to poor weather conditions, students and teachers will continue with learning that has taken place in their classroom through learning at home. The lessons and tasks will be related to classroom curriculum goals and skills.

A maximum of five (5) days will be utilized as E-Learning days.

On a school cancellation day, the superintendent will inform staff and students of the E-Learning day. This announcement will be made prior to 6:30 a.m. via School Messenger System, on the district website and through other media outlets. The announcement will clearly state if it is an E-Learning day. If there is no such announcement, there is no E-Learning day. The school is not open to students on an E-Learning day.

Attendance is taken as E-Learning assignments are marked complete. Students have up to two (2) school days to complete E-Learning assignments and submit them to the teacher.

Instruction will take place through Google Classroom and/or E-Learning packets that will be sent home. Students are not required to access virtual classes on an E-Learning day.

Elementary teachers will provide information about E-Learning assignments at fall Parent Conferences. Grades 7-12 teachers will post the assignment via email or Google Classroom by 8:15. Teachers are available via email between 9:00 a.m. and 3:15 p.m.

Special education teachers will collaborate with regular education teachers to modify and adapt E-Learning assignments to meet the needs of students. If a student receives instruction in the special education setting, that teacher will develop the E-Learning assignments. Provisions and accommodations will be made for students with an individual education plan (IEP) as needed and appropriate.

Frequently Asked Questions

What if my teacher is gone on an E-Learning day?

It will be rare that a teacher won't be able to at least send an email message to students that they are not available that day. If that does happen, the teacher will get back to you once they return.

Can I call with questions?

You can call the school at 218 436 2261 and leave a message for the teacher. They may not get back to you until the next school day.
