What: Drivers Education will be offered this spring by Tri-County Schools. Mr. Spilde will be teaching classroom and behind-the-wheel training. Students are required to attend 30 hours of classroom training and 6 hours of behind-the-wheel training.

Who: Students should be 15 by June 1st 2026

When: Classroom training will be as follows:

Sunday March 1st 3pm-6pm
Sunday March 8th 3pm-6pm
Sunday March 15th 3pm – 6pm
Sunday March 22nd 3pm – 6pm
Sunday March 29th 3pm – 6pm
Sunday April 12th 3pm – 6pm
Sunday April 19th 3pm – 6pm
Sunday April 26th 3pm – 6pm
Sunday May 3rd 3pm – 6pm

Class will be taught at the Tri-County school building. Behind-the-wheel training will be scheduled when students have passed the permit test.

Cost: The fee for classroom and behind-the-wheel training is \$300, which must be paid before classes begin. Make your check out to Tri-County Schools.

Other: All students taking the permit test must have these three forms of identification.

1. A blue card signed by the Drivers Education instructor.
2. A certified birth certificate- copies of a birth certificate are not allowed.
3. A social security card.
4. Student must pass a vision test after passing permit test.
